## **Congressional Candidate Ted Harvey reiterates unwavering commitment to Republican Caucus and Assembly Process in 4<sup>th</sup> District**

**HIGHLANDS RANCH, Colorado:** Today, former State Senator Ted Harvey, and candidate for Colorado's 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District, issued the following statement regarding his unwavering commitment to participate in the District 4 Congressional Assembly on Friday, April 5th, as well as encouraging his opponents to renew their commitment to the grassroots process as well:

“For months, I have joined eight other candidates vying for the 4th Congressional District as we’ve crisscrossed the 21 counties that make up this large district. Each of these candidates have made promises to numerous audiences on their public policy positions, but just as important, on their respect for the candidate nominating process.

As the only candidate 100% committed to only going through the Assembly, I was disappointed to learn one of my opponents, Deborah Flora, broke a key promise she has consistently made over the last five months to the district’s voters: respecting the grassroots of the Republican Party and committing to the Assembly process.

Since announcing my candidacy in early December, I have traveled thousands of miles meeting with numerous groups stretching from Lamar to Parker and Loveland to Sterling. I have always promised to every Republican that calls the 4th Congressional District home: I respect our wonderful communities and the hard work our Republican volunteers invest to make the “Grand Old Party” strong and relevant. Which is why I honor the caucus and Assembly process and have worked to earn the support of our grassroots throughout its 21 counties.

I have always been dismayed at the amount of money that pours into our elections where candidates hire paid contractors to collect petition signatures from citizens who have no understanding of who the candidate are. Then, these same politicians have the temerity to

call their efforts “grassroots”. It’s insulting to the countless hours put in by party volunteers across our great state.

I remind my competitors: this congressional seat is NOT for sale, and our grassroots Republicans know it.
